

# Baghdad energy storage project bidding

Will Iraq build a waste-to-energy plant in Baghdad?

Last month, Iraq invited companies to bid for a project to build a waste-to-energy plant in Baghdad within a post-war scheme to develop its infrastructure and services. The National Investment Commission (NIC) will oversee the execution of the project, which it considers as a "pioneering plan for electricity production."

Which Chinese companies won a bid for Baghdad oil & gas?

Five bids were won on Saturday by Chinese companies. Zhongman Petroleum and Natural Gas Group (ZPEC) (603619.SS) took the northern extension of the Eastern Baghdad field, in Baghdad, and the Middle Euphrates field that straddles the southern Najaf and Karbala provinces, the oil ministry said.

Who won a bid to develop Abu Khema oilfield in Iraq?

The field is shared by the provinces of Najaf and Anbar in southern Iraq. It also won a bid to develop Abu Khema oilfield in the southern Muthanna province and will get 9.1 per cent of the net profit. China's Geo-Jade won a bid to develop Zurbatiya block in Wasit province in central Iraq.

Will Iraq produce unspecified quantities of energy?

The project will produce unspecified quantities of energy and sell it to the electricity ministry at prices to be agreed on later, it said in a statement carried by Aliqtisad News and other Iraqi publications on Wednesday.

A total of 93 projects were submitted into the auction, with 12 winners, 3 runner-ups and 78 projects which were excluded from the final list. Projects bid in with a desired annual aid amount, with a weighted average of the winning projects of EUR49,748 per MW per year. This is less than half of the upper limit that projects could bid in at, of EUR115,000.

Iraq has selected the winning bid for the construction of a waste-to-energy plant in the capital Baghdad, the head of the National Investment Commission (NIC) has said. Haider Makiya told the official Iraqi News Agency in weekend comments that the winning firm has experience in environment and energy projects.

Chinese enterprises emerged as the primary winners in Iraq's latest energy sector bidding round, a pivotal move as the West Asian country aims to boost its oil and gas reserves and financial inflow. Launched on Saturday, the three-day event showcased 29 oil and gas projects, with 21 auctioned over the weekend.

The package is part of the Baghdad water supply and sewerage improvement project, which the Washington-based World Bank Group is coordinating. MPE offered to undertake the project for \$13.9m. The contract duration is 545 days. Other companies that submitted bids for the contract are: Al-Jindar Construction & General Trading (local): \$17.29m

This is another historic breakthrough made by ZPEC in the upstream exploration, development, and production market of the "Belt and Road" ...
