Brazil launched on Thursday its first large-scale energy storage system with a total capacity of 30 MW, power sector regulator Aneel announced.

How many people benefit from battery energy storage in Brazil?

The project benefits more than 2 million people in Brazil. ISA CTEEP, a leader in Brazil's power transmission sector, has just energized the first large-scale battery energy storage project in the Brazilian transmission system. The batteries were installed in an area of approximately 5.000 m<sup>2</sup>, which is the equivalent of half a soccer field.

Brazil leads Latin America in renewable energy, with hydropower accounting for 55%, wind energy at 15%, and solar at 6%. In the past five years, the country's wind energy capacity has doubled, growing from 13,240 MW in 2018 to 27,529 MW in 2023.
