According to the Renewable Energy Hub, domestic solar panel systems usually range in size from around to 1 kW to 5 kW. Allowing for some cloudier days, and some lost power, a 5 kW system can ...

The scheme allows a company to pay solar panel owners to release the remainder of their FiT. Many solar panel owners bought solar panels when the FiT was either still active, or at its highest rate.
