Which airport has the largest runway in Cape Verde?

Amílcar Cabral International Airport,located on Sal Island,has the largest runway in Cape Verde. With a length of 3,000m,a width of 45m and a capacity to receive seven large aircraft,Amílcar Cabral International Airport is considered the alternate airport for NASA Space Shuttles.

What are Cape Verde's transport priorities?

Where is Cabo Verde Airport?

It is located two km west-southwest from Espargos on Sal Island. Sal is the main hub for the national airline, Cabo Verde Airlines; and serves as a base for carrier Cabo Verde Express. This airport was also one of NASA's locations for a facility to handle the Space Shuttle after reentering from orbit.

Will Cape Verde connect to the world as air services resume?

Cape Verdean Prime Minister wants to connect the country to the world as air services resume. The aviation regulatory regime of Cape Verde has been scrutinised and its revision will be a major plank of the new order. Cabo Verde 's Prime Minister, Ulisses Correia e Silva, has outlined the government's transport priorities to "unify" the domestic market, which is spread across 10 islands, and to "connect the country with the rest of the world." Inaugurated in 1960, it is located near the village of Sã0 Pedro, in the Ribeira de Sã0 Pedro valley, about 5 km southwest of the center of Mindelo, Cape Verde"s second-largest city. With a runway 2,000 meters long and 45 meters wide, Cesária Évora International Airport can accommodate five C-class aircraft on its platform and around 550 ...

Until September 2005, it was the only airport in Cape Verde to serve international flights. (Cape Verde's other international airports are near Praia on Santiago Island, on Sao Vicente near the capital of Mindelo and on Boavista.) The airport's main runway (01/19) is 3,272m (10,734 ft) and is the longest in Cape Verde.
