How long should you keep food after 'use by' date?

Make sure that you do not use food after its 'use by' date. For dishes you have prepared or cooked, it is a good idea to use stickers, or another method of labelling, to keep track of when food should be used or thrown away. If you are not sure how long to keep food, ask your environmental health officer for advice.

How long can you keep food in a freezer?

Freezers should always be kept at -18°C or less. All freezers should have a star rating, so consult your freezer's handbook: As a general rule and to maintain the quality, food should not be stored in a freezer for longer than 6 months (provided that your freezer is suitable for storing foods for this length of time).

How long can you keep cold food out of a Buffet?

When you display cold food, e.g. on a buffet, you should use suitable chilled display equipment to keep it at 8°C or below. If this is not possible, you can display food out of chilled storage for up to four hours, but you can only do this once. Make sure you know how long food has been on display or kept out, and check its temperature regularly.

How long does frozen food last?

The storage time of frozen foods can vary depending on the type of product and the temperature at which it is stored. Whilst it's not possible to offer exact storage times, an average product life can be estimated based on a variety of factors.

How long can you keep leftover food in the fridge?

Leftovers should be kept covered in the fridge and used within 2-3 days. In addition, it is good practice to clear out the fridge on a regular basis to ensure that any out of date foods are discarded. Freezers should always be kept at -18°C or less. All freezers should have a star rating, so consult your freezer's handbook:

What temperature should frozen food be stored?

It also cites recommended fridge temperatures of 5°C or below, and a legal requirement to store cold foods below 8°C . For frozen foods, the guidance states that fresh foods must be frozen before midnight on the use-by date and re-labelled correctly. It also states that FBOs need to keep frozen foods at a temperature of -18°C .
