How long can breast milk be stored?

Breast milk can be stored between 4 and 8 days in a fridge running between 0 and 4°C. If the fridge temperature goes above 4°C during this time, use your milk within 6 hours or throw away. (24 hours). Protect your milk from the ice packs or it may freeze. The bag can also be used to carry milk. If you wish to store your breast milk for longer than

How long can milk be stored in the fridge?

It can be stored in the fridge (at a temperature of 4 degrees Celsius) for between 4 and 8 days. It can also be kept in a freezer for up to 6 months. Milk needs to be placed in either the fridge or freezer as soon after expressing as possible. Try to use a new container every time you express.

Can breast milk be stored in a sterilised container?

You can store breast milk in a sterilised container or in special breast milk storage bags: Breast milk that's been cooled in the fridge can be carried in a cool bag with ice packs for up to 24 hours. Storing breast milk in small quantities will help avoid waste. If you're freezing it, make sure you label and date it first.

How long can breast milk be stored in a cooler bag?

For these occasions, keep an insulated cooler bag ready to store breast milk. Once it's been cooled in the fridge, breast milk can be carried in a cooler bag for up to 24 hours, provided that the bag also contains ice packs. We recommend that you start expressing a few days before you need to.

How do you store frozen breast milk?

Breast milk can be stored in a sterilised container, or special storage bags - remember to label and date it. Store it in small quantities to avoid wasting any. Your breast milk can then be kept: The best way to defrost frozen breast milk is by leaving it in the fridge to thaw out completely before use.

How do you store breast milk after thawing?

You can keep stored milk: Store breast milk at the back of the fridge, on the shelf above the vegetable compartment. This is the coldest part of the fridge. Do not store in the fridge door as the temperature is less consistent. Previously frozen breast milk can be kept in the refrigerator for 24 hours after thawing.

If refrigeration is available, store milk there. No more than 72 hours. Store at the back, where it is coldest. 2 weeks in freezer compartment inside refrigerator (-15°C) 3 months in freezer section of refrigerator with separate door (-18°C) 6 ...

Freshly expressed breast milk can be kept at room temperature for up to six hours. However, it's optimal to use or properly store the breast milk within four hours, especially if the room is warm. Insulated cooler.

The best method depends on the type of milk, the desired shelf life, and the storage conditions. Pasteurized milk can be stored in its original container in the refrigerator for up to 2 weeks. For longer storage, pasteurized milk can be frozen for up to 6 months. Raw milk can be stored in the refrigerator for up to 2 days.
