How much do solar panels cost per square foot?

On average, solar panels cost \$8.77 per square footof living space, after factoring in the 30% tax credit. However, the cost per square foot varies based on the size of the home. For example, the post-tax credit cost of solar panels for a 2,500-square-foot home is around \$20,000 for a rate of \$7.96 per square foot.

How much does a rooftop solar system cost?

Mounting system: This is what holds rooftop solar panels in place. Costs vary depending on the type of solar installation, but it generally costs between 7 and 20 cents per watt. Electrical wiring and hardware: This includes the wiring, switches and circuit breakers required to connect the solar panel system to your home's electrical system.

How much does a solar system cost?

Solar panel costs are calculated by the price per watt. The average price per watt in the U.S. is \$3.67for an 8.6 kW system (rounded up). Compare the average cost of solar in the U.S. based on system size before applying incentives. To estimate how much a system will cost, multiply the price per watt by the system size.

How much does a 5 kilowatt solar system cost?

The average 5-kilowatt (kW) solar panel system is \$14,210before considering any financial incentives. However, a typical American household needs a system closer to 10 kW to adequately power their home, which costs \$28,241 in 2024. That price effectively drops to \$19,873 after considering the full federal solar tax credit.
