How long does it take to remove solar panels?

How do you dismantle a solar panel?

Disconnect Electrical Components and Turn Off System Switch off the solar electric system at the main utility panel. Then, individually unplug all electrical connectors on panels, disconnect the inverter and batteries, and label all wires clearly.
