

Poland's first shared energy storage

Will Poland have a power storage system?

The project has obtained the first license promise in Poland for electricity storage, PGE said in a press release. The storage system will be set up at the 716-MW Zarnowiec pumped-storage power plant with 3,600 MWh of storage capacity. The hybrid system will be capable of supplying power to about 200,000 households for at least five hours.

Why is PGE preparing a new energy storage facility in Zarnowiec?

The battery will improve the reliability of the local distribution network and support the connection of more renewable energy capacity in the area. PGE aims to build at least 800 MW of energy storage capacity by 2030 and it is already preparing one bigger project -- a 205 MW/820 MWh facility in Zarnowiec.

What is the strategic goal of the energy storage group?

The strategic goal of the Group in the area of energy storage is to have 800 MW of new energy storage installed capacity in Poland by 2030. The energy stores will ensure safe system integration of new renewable energy sources, will contribute to stabilization of the power system and will improve the country's energy security.

What is PGE's new energy storage facility?

The project, expected to be tendered in mid-2024, aims to support the balancing of PGE's land and offshore wind farms on the Baltic Sea. Funded by the National Recovery Plan, the storage facility will enhance the stability of the National Power System during the energy transition and provide a stable revenue source for PGE.

Storage auctions: Hungary is set to have its first storage auction for around 900MWh of new electricity storage by the end of 2026. Currently, Poland has a total installed storage capacity of 1.4 GW, 85% of which comes from pumped hydro storage facilities. Looking ahead, 2.1 GW of BESS capacity is slated to come online by 2028. 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MOSS aims to address this key challenge of variable energy supply by testing an energy storage system using the molten hydroxide salt commonly referred to as drain cleaner. This salt is comparatively less expensive and more accessible than molten salts used for energy storage to date. The pilot plant is expected to go operational in 2024.

This is also the first energy storage project in the Polish market, operated in partnership with ML System S.A., a pioneering firm in Poland's solar energy sector. The newly launched energy storage project will be combined with a 1MW solar power plant also produced and sold by BYD, enabling peak shaving and create a more balanced power network.
