

Replacing the alternator belt of Fengjun 5 pickup truck

How much does alternator belt replacement cost?

The alternator belt replacement cost (also known as serpentine belt, v-belt, drive belt or fan belt) are made up of material costs (approx. \$20 - \$30) and labour costs (approx. \$60 - \$200). For most vehicles, costs of around \$80 - \$230 can be expected.

Do I need to change the alternator belt?

In most cases it is sufficient to change only the alternator belt (or serpentine belt) and there are no additional costs. Occasionally, however, an additional change of alternator belt tensioner and pulley makes sense, as the material costs are low compared to the labour costs.

How do I know if my alternator belt needs replacing?

You can check if alternator belt needs replacing by doing the following steps: Check the belt tension, if you push on the belt and it moves more than 1/8 inch to a 1/4 inch then it means that it is worn out and needs replacing, now you can go on ahead and remove it. Releasing the tension on the belt will allow you to remove it.

How long does alternator belt replacement take?

The average alternator belt replacement time will take roughly between 30 - 60 minutes, provided that no further work is necessary. The alternator belt replacement is therefore surprisingly fast when compared to other car repairs. A big advantage when changing is the easy access to the alternator belt.

What does the alternator belt do?

The alternator belt (or drive belt) is a rubber belt up to 160 cm long and is responsible for transferring power from the engine to the auxiliary units. In addition to the alternator, the alternator belt also operates the power steering, the water pump, the hydraulic pump and the fan. What causes alternator belt to break / snap?

What happens if the alternator belt fails?

1; The electronics may fail The alternator belt also drives the alternator and this starts the car battery. Without the alternator, electric accessories such as A/C, radio or plugs will only run on the remaining energy of the car battery.

Increase the tension on the belt. If your vehicle does not have an auto tensioner, insert a pry bar or piece of wood between the alternator and the engine. Run the belt over the alternator pulley, then use the bar to pry the alternator away from the engine and increase the tension on the belt. Tighten the bolts again as you apply tension.

However, several problems can emerge as the alternator belt ages. For example, it can start to fray, wear, crack, or peel, as well as become loose or misaligned. Replacing the belt in good time is the best way to prevent ...

Follow the serpentine or accessory belts to locate the alternator in your engine bay. Depending on the vehicle, it may be on the top closest to you, or it may be on one of the sides and difficult to access. ... To change an alternator, park the vehicle on an even, level surface, and disconnect the cable from the negative battery terminal ...
