Installing solar panels involves a detailed process:

Solar photovoltaic panels or modules that are designed to be the roof, span to structural supports and have accessible/occupied space underneath shall have the panels or modules and all supporting structures designed to support a roof photovoltaic live load, as defined in Section CS507.1.1.1 (IBC 1607.13.5.1) in combination with other applicable loads.

Monocrystalline solar panels are the most cost-effective option. Perovskite panels are more efficient and will be on the market soon. Thin film panels are the cheapest, most versatile choice. It's confusing enough trying to find solar panel prices, never mind choosing between the different types of solar panels to pick the right one for your home.

This is because a solar panel system usually weighs about 20kg per square metre, which the great majority of roofs can hold. However, flat roofs may not always be strong enough for solar panels. Drilling into a flat roof can cause leaks, so an installer will usually ballast the panels instead - but these will add around 80kg per panel.

Solar panels can be designed to fit the space you have, accommodating for chimneys and unusual roof shapes. The average 3.5kWp solar PV system will take up around 20m² of roof space, which is the same as about two car parking spaces. A professionally implemented solar panel installation should not damage your roof. The only situation in which a properly accredited and certified installer will damage any part of your roof is if you have slate tiles that can't sit on a roof hook without breaking, in which case they'll drill a small hole through the tile and into the rafter.

Finding an unshaded spot is best, but sometimes shading is unavoidable. Some solar panel systems can minimise the impact of shading using "optimisers". Solar optimisers help improve the overall performance of your solar panel system. So, if one panel is shaded, it doesn't impact how much electricity the other panels can

The initial choice is whether to use a complete solar roof system or a system in which the solar takes up only a part of the roof. FM disallows the use of any PV panel systems using foam plastics, unless specifically FM approved as part of the assembly. FM Approval Standards 4476 and 4478 for Flexible and Rigid PV Modules address fire, simulated wind uplift, hail damage, and heat aging of the panels a part of the finished roof assembly.
