How does a solar panel installation work?

The installer will have to lift some of the roof tiles to fix the anchors to the rafters in the loft. This will give the solar panel mounts a stable foundation, and will make sure they don't get damaged in stormy weather. Once the roof anchors have been fixed to the property, the installer will attach the solar panel mounting system to them.

Can solar panels be installed vertically or horizontally?

The panels themselves can be installed vertically or horizontally. Once the mounting system is set up, it's time for the moment we've all been waiting for: getting the solar panels onto the roof. Your installer will start by placing the solar panels onto the mounting system, without fully securing them just yet.

How do solar panels attach to a roof?

Installers fix solar panels to a roof by lifting up some roof tiles and attaching mounting brackets to the rafters, before carefully placing the tiles back where they were. They'll then attach rails to these brackets, before locking solar panels into the rails.

Are solar panels easy to install?
