Estimate the energy needs of your building before installing a solar panel. A solar panel comprises 36 to 72 PV cells. Each cell generates about 0.5 V. Installation cost. Solar panel installation costs may range from Rs 40,000 to Rs 6,00,000. It can cost higher for larger installations. Mid-range solar panels are suited for residential purposes.
